FISHING REGULATIONS FOR 2011

Article 1 : All anglers must purchase a fishing permit, for half a day, a day, a week or for the year issued by the Community of Communauté of Communes Brame-Benaize, available in retail outlets closest to the pond, shown below.

Article 2 : Fishing is allowed around the lake and on the beach. Fishing is prohibited on the beach from June 5th to September 12th 2010. No fishing from boats is permitted on the lake

Article 3 : Fishing is authorised from 1 hour before sunrise until 1 hour after sunset.

- Start of the season : **Saturday 9th April 2011** at 7.00 am
- Finish of the season : **Saturday 31 December 2011** in the evening

Article 4 : Fishing is permitted with up to a maximum of 3 floating lines, with sinkers, an artificial lure or dead fish bait. For each additional line, the angler must purchase a supplementary day permit. Fishing is free for children under 12 using a single line.

Article 5 : The daily authorised catch is limited to 10 kg, of which there can be a maximum of 6 trout, 2 carnivorous species (pike, pike-perch, perch, carp or roach) or fountain salmon. Pike smaller than 50 cm and pikeperch smaller than 45 cm must be returned to the water. The carp anglers must have a landing mat on the fishing station and the necessary equipment to treat injured fish before their release to water. Carp larger than 4kg must be thrown back in. No tiger nuts or peanuts for hooking or baiting.

Article 6 : Fishing permits are sold in the establishments mentioned in the press or on the official notices and the angler must be in possession of a valid permit before he starts fishing.

Article 7 : Fishing is strictly forbidden outside the dates given in Article 3.

Article 8 : If an angler is unable to present a valid permit to a licensed warden when requested, he will be required to purchase a yearly permit that same day. Refusal to comply with this or any other breach of the regulations will lead to a fine.

Article 9 : The amount of the fine has been fixed at the cost of the yearly permit plus 40€, therefore 130€.

Article 10 : Anglers must respect the environment, using the bins provided and leaving their post/swim in the same state as they would wish to find it.

Article 11: All fishing rods in use must be set up near their owner and kept under their continued surveillance. The fishing warden is authorised to confiscate any rod that has been left unattended.

Article 12 : No catfish (silure) caught must be returned to the water alive. For parts above 1 meter, immediately notify the Keeper (06 47 43 42 96) who evacuate living on another site.

Article 13 : fishing is prohibited within the perimeter of the reserve located at the bottom fishing pond, the banks reported on by signs.
